PEDDLERS/TRANSIENT MERCHANTS/SOLICITORS  
RULES/REGULATIONS

Listed below are sections of the *Savage City Code* pertaining to licensed peddlers/transient merchants/solicitors. These rules/regulations are enforced by the City of Savage.

3-3-9:           **PRACTICES PROHIBITED:**

- A.     No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall call attention to their business or to their merchandise by crying out, by blowing a horn, or ringing a bell or by the making of other noise of such volume that it is audible within the confines of an enclosed dwelling structure.
- B.     No peddler or solicitor shall enter in or upon any premises or attempt to enter in or upon any premises wherein a sign or placard bearing the notice "Peddlers or Solicitors Prohibited" or language similar thereto is located.
- C.     No peddler or solicitor shall refuse to leave a premise when requested to do so by the owner, lessee or person in charge of the premises or to otherwise conduct business in a manner that a reasonable person would find obscene, threatening, intimidating or abusive.
- D.     No business shall be conducted before nine o'clock (9:00) a.m. or after eight o'clock (8:00) p.m.
- E.     No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall obstruct the free flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic on any street, alley, sidewalk, required parking area (whether public or private) or other public right-of-way.
- F.     No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall refuse/fail to provide proof of license or registration when requested by the property owner or representative of the city.
- G.     No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall make any false or misleading statements about the product or service being sold, including untrue statements of endorsements. No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall claim to have the endorsement of the City solely based on the City having issued a license or certificate of registration to that person.

3-3-10:           **PENALTY:**

Any person who violates any provision of this Article shall upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor under Minnesota law and shall pay the cost of prosecution. For purposes of this Article, each day a violation exists shall constitute a separate violation.

3-3-6:           **SUSPENSION OF LICENSE:**

Any license issued under and pursuant to this Article may be suspended by the Chief of Police without notice if the licensee:

- A.     Uses fraud, misrepresentation or false statements during the course of licensed activity.
- B.     Has been convicted of any offense for which granting of a license could have been denied under this Article.

- C. Conducts the business in an unlawful manner or such a manner as to constitute a breach of peace, or to constitute a menace to the health, safety or general welfare of the public.
- D. Violates any part of this Article.

3-3-7: **REVOCAION OF LICENSE**

A. **Notification:**

After the suspension of any license issued under this Article, the City shall provide the license holder with written notice of the alleged violation(s) and inform the licensee of his or her right to a hearing on the alleged violation. Notice shall be delivered in person or by mail to the permanent residential address listed on the license application, or if no residential address is listed, to the business address provided on the license application.

B. **Public Hearing:**

Upon receipt of such notification, the licensee shall have the right to request a public hearing. If no request for a hearing is received by the City Clerk within ten (10) regular business days following the service of the notice, the City may proceed with the revocation. If a public hearing is requested within the stated timeframe, a hearing shall be scheduled within twenty (20) days from the date of the request. Within three (3) regular business days of the hearing, the City Council shall notify the licensee of its decision.

C. **Appeal:**

Any person whose license is suspended or revoked under this article shall have the right to appeal that decision in court.
